The children will practice printing the letters Ee and Ff when working on their phonics papers. During craft time, the children will decorate their names with colored paper squares.

Math, Science & Social Studies

In Math, the children will learn the shapes *rhombus, half circle* and *trapezoid.* We will explore how to make a pattern.

In Science, the children will be doing experiments related to the sense of taste, smell and hearing.

Language Arts/Phonics

Our focus this week is on the letters Ee and Ff. Readiness paper will concentrate on proper letter formation and phonetic sounds. The children will learn that the letter E is a vowel and that it makes a long and short vowel sound. We will also be learning about *rhyming words*.
