## Theme- Five Senses

## Expressive Vocabulary-

Expedite: to quicken, to speed the process or event
Fatigue: the condition or state of being tired
Gloat: to look or think about something with great satisfaction
Heritage: something that is handed down from earlier generations or from the past
Bits of Intelligence: Insects
Manners: Say "please"/ Say "thank you"
Fable: Week 3 The Lion and the Mouse and Week 4 The Grasshopper and the Ants A fable is a story that teaches a lesson and the lesson we learn is called a moral.
Introductions- Letters: Ee and Ff/Gg and Hh
Author Study- Eric Carle
Language Arts: We will be working on letters $\mathrm{Ee}, \mathrm{Ff}, \mathrm{Gg}$ and Hh the next two weeks. The children will learn about compound words and make a list of them. Each week we will hear a story from a book called Willy the Wisher. These stories encourage children to draw their conclusions based on the information given. Concept: Each day we are learning to write the date on our calendar and are counting the days of school using a place value chart. We are counting to 100 and clapping on the 10's. This is a great activity to practice with your child. We will practice sequencing with 3and 4 scene picture cards. Continued discussion our five senses will take place. We will see how important they are when learning about the world. Hearing will be introduced through a fun listening bingo game. Week 4 of our five senses lessons will conclude with the sense of taste. The boys and girls will learn that we taste food with our tongue through our taste buds. We will be discussing during meal times which menu items taste sour, sweet, salty, spicy, and bland. Our science experiment this week will focus on absorption. We will be making predictions as to how many cotton balls it will take to soak up the water.
