Language Arts: We will begin to work on basic story words. The story words will be listed in the newsletters. Please practice these at home with your child. We will review them at school as well. Our class will be working on rhyming words, patterning and graphing through fun learning activities. The boys and girls will continue their writing practice to strengthen our fine motor skills and proper letter formation. Here is a catchy song we will sing to help learn about firefighters:
