Language Arts: This week we will be talking about the letters Aa and Bb. We will work on printing these letters as well as learning about their phonetic sounds. We will learn that Aa is a special letter because it is a vowel and makes a long and short sound. We will also be reading many books about beginning school and I will be listening to your child read! We will begin reading our Bold Beginning Stories and in the next few we will begin our Guided Reading Program, more information to follow.

Math: We will begin our math unit with place value. The children will use straws to show the amount of days they have been in school. When we get to ten, we put a rubber band around the straws and move them from the ones bin to the tens. Wait until you see our big celebration on the 100th day of school! We will also do review of numbers 1-20 and learn about sets. The boys and girls will learn that a set is a group of things which belong together.

Science: Does your child know about primary and secondary colors? They will after this week. The boys and girls will discover what happens when you mix colors together. Look for a color mixing project to come home at the end of this week.

<u>Social Studies</u>: We will be exploring our classroom and discussing our classroom rules and procedures.
