Weeks 4 and 5: September 4-15, 2017 Theme: Pets/Working Animals

Language Arts:

We will focus on our new reading words and our second story, String Bean! Also, the children will learn the letters Ee and Ff. Several phonics games will help to introduce these next two letters of the alphabet. The children will be learning animals that can be pets and help people. The children will learn how to care for animals, the sounds they make, and what they look like. We'll be playing veterinarian as we take care of our stuffed animals in the classroom. We will be saying please and thank you, as we share our vet set! In addition, we'll discuss the importance and meaning of

our first proverb, do unto others. Lastly, we'll create our own stories dictated by the children. *If you have a pet, please bring in a picture of it.

Concept:

Animals will be taking over our classroom! They will be filling our estimation jars, mystery bag, and shelf jobs! The children will be identifying these new numbers, and answering questions such as greater than and less than. Number jobs will help the children build their number concept skills. The letters Ee and Ff will be added to all alphabet jobs, and circles and squares to shape jobs.

Doggie, Doggie, Where's Your Bone?, the balance beam, and ball play will be enjoyed. We will be acting like pets as we hop like bunnies, bark like dogs, and swim like fish.
