Week 5: September 11-15, 2017

Theme: A Trip to the Zoo

Language Arts:

The zoo is our topic this week, and we will be reading several books about zoo animals including: *Animals*, by Anne Wilson. The children will also learn the finger plays *Playful Zoo Friends* and *I'll See Them at the Zoo*. We will also be looking at pictures of various zoo animals. Can you point to the zebra? The tiger? The children will enjoy animal puppet plays and songs!

Concept:

We will be paying special attention to the weather, as we anticipate the fall season. The children will have shelf time, and try several new letter A jobs. Jobs will also help us to review the colors red and blue, and shapes circle and square.

Motor:

We will be taking turns crawling through the tunnel. What animal will you pretend to be as

We will be working on our coloring, painting, and gluing skills. We'll be creating a classroom zoo, so keep your eyes peeled for our animals!
