Language Arts:

We will enjoy several fun fall finger plays. Can you make your fingers look like the leaves that will be falling off of our trees? The children will enjoy singing the song Fall is Here. Storytime will consist of books on our season, including: Pumpkins, Apples, and Leaves.

Concept:
