
Bobbie Noonan's Child Care Junior's Newsletter August 28 - September 1, 2017

Language:

Craft & Writing:

This week the children will be completing papers that reinforce our shapes: circle and square. Scissor skills will be practiced with straight line cutting papers. Shaving cream and play-doh will be used for building our fine motor skills. The children will also be painting dinosaurs.

Concept:

If you have any dinosaurs that you would like to send to school for our science table display, please be sure they are labeled with your child's name. We will be discussing various types of dinosaurs. The children will also be working on estimation this week. We will add circle and square to our shelf activities.

Motor:

The children will be playing a game by following directions. We will also be going outside weather permitting.
