Language: For the next 2 weeks in Language we will have fun with flannel board stories and finger plays such as “Mary Had a Little Lamb,” “Little Miss Muffet,” “This Little Piggy,” and “Hey Diddle Diddle.” Our picture file will be based on our favorite nursery Rhymes. The children will continue to go over Aa and our A is for Amos song. This week we will introduce the colors green and yellow and review all that has been introduced.

Motor: We will continue to go outside, play our following direction game, and use our push toys. We’ll have fun playing a tossing game using different sized balls and buckets.

Concept: This week in concept we will play review games to reinforce concepts and learn the colors yellow and green. We’ll do an activity that helps us understand long/short and big/small. We will also continue with shelf time and the calendar. On Thursday and Friday the water table will be introduced and we’ll practice squeezing the water out of sponges and pouring.

Art: This week the children will enjoy coloring, painting, and mosaicing Nursery Rhyme pictures. We’ll also have fun with play doh and shaving cream.
