Language Arts: We will begin to work on basic sight words and add them to our word wall as they are introduced. Our sight words are a list of words that should be learned in kindergarten and will help your young student become a more fluent reader. The sight words will be listed in each newsletter. Please practice these at home with your child. We will continue to work on word families dealing with -ap and -ed. Our class will be working on rhyming words, patterning and graphing through fun learning activities. New manners will be introduced and we will discuss different everyday situations when we need to remember to use our manners. The boys and girls will continue their printing practice to strengthen their fine motor skills and proper letter formation. Here is a catchy song we will sing to help learn about firefighters:

I Am A Firefighter
(sung to "I'm A Little Teapot")
I am a firefighter dressed in red.
With my fire hat on my head.
I can drive the firetruck, fight fires too,
And help make things safe for me and you.

**Math**: The children have been doing a great job counting to 100. We will now add counting by 10's to our math activities. This week the boys and girls will complete number activities where they hold number cards and place themselves in a line to show correct number sequence from 1-10. We will also practice matching numeral cards to written numerals (ex. 1 goes with one). A fun geo board activity will help your young student understand rows, columns, and ordinal numbers.

**Science:** We will learn about fire fighters and how they keep us safe. We will discuss the different clothing fire fighters wear and we will learn different ways to stay safe from fires. The boys and girls will have fun sorting objects into hot and cold categories. We will discuss how to prevent fires and what we would do at school if there was a fire.

**Social Studies**: The children will enjoy learning some more about our great state of Illinois. We will learn about our state flower and bird, along with finding Illinois on the map.
