Our topic this week is dinosaurs. During our study of dinosaurs, the children will be learning new words and their meanings.

Some new words: omnivorous, herbivorous, carnivorous, extinct, fossil and prehistoric.

Review story 1 & 2 Taffy Apple, Run, run, Jump, jump, String Bean, Come, and.

I will be reading some dinosaur books to the children, we will use our drama skills to pretend we are dinosaurs.

Introduce: Gg and Hh

Language Arts: Review letters and phonic sounds for letters A thru H.

We will play a game called “Beat the Bell”.

We will play this game and review letters, phonic sounds, and story words.

“Simon Says” will also be played to reinforce our listening skills.

Bits cards: “Dinosaurs” We will learn special facts about dinosaurs.

Vocabulary word; Gullible-easily fooled

Manners: Talk with an empty mouth Eat with a spoon and fork

Fable: The Lion and the Mouse Moral– Sometimes we can help, even if we are small.



Concept: We will discuss dinosaurs and add items to our science table to go with our theme.

Numbers 7 and 8 will be introduced while we continue our daily routine and work with the calendar and weather chart. I will introduce to the children the spindle box, knob cylinders, pink tower and the brown stairs.

These activities will help train the eye to perceive fine differences in dimension.

We will work on an estimation activity and our sand table will be open for a dinosaur dig searching for fossils.

Science- Volcano experiment

The children will be introduced to the tactile bag.

Craft and Writing: 7 and 8 papers, dinosaur craft, have fun painting with Q-tips.
