Concept:

I will be introducing some geometric shapes to the children. Most have mastered basic shapes, so it's time to take a more advanced step. Shapes to know are cube, cylinder, cone and sphere.

When counting with your child, keep one to one correspondence in mind. A good way to reinforce this would be to have your child count out different items in your home. For example, they could be asked to count out twelve buttons for you. In doing this you can be sure they understand what the number twelve represents.
