Concept

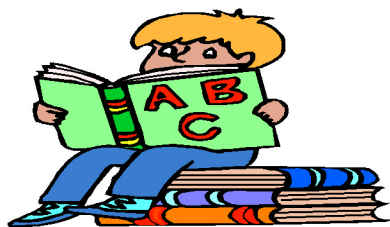

Craft and Writing

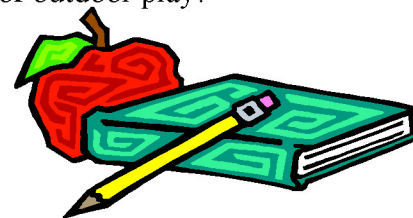
