Concept

In Mrs. Ann's room the children will do quite a few group activities involving the tactile bag. One of these activities will contain a bristle block, a unit block, a sponge, Post It note paper, a small book, an index card and a felt square. Every day, two new facts about dinosaurs will be introduced. Mrs. Ann will use miniature dinosaur figurines to help identify the many types of dinosaurs. This week the children will estimate how many crayons are in the "Estimation Jar". The children will enjoy a hands-on activity that will require them to "dig" dinosaurs from the sand.
