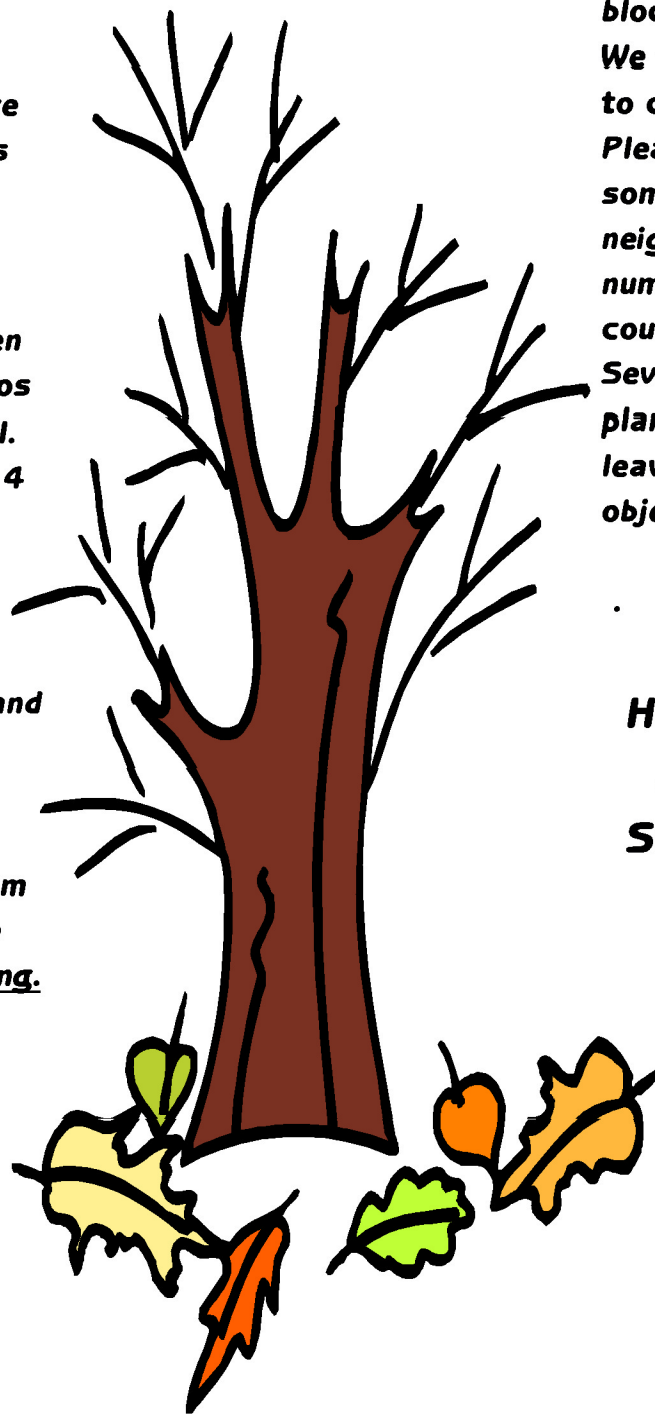
Bits of Intelligence: Mammals
