Introduction:

LANGUAGE ARTS: Reading stories 1-3 will be reviewed, along with the letters Aa through Nn for recognition and phonetic sounds. Books and puppets on *Community Workers* will enhance our theme discussions. Rhythm sticks will help develop our listening skills. Please send in books or pictures about *Community Helpers* to share with the class. To enhance our theme discussions, please write down what Mom and Dad do at their jobs everyday and we will explain it to the children.

CRAFT AND WRITING: The colors *purple* and *brown* will be used in our craft activities this week. Fine motor skills are developed as we trace the number 3 and 4 and practice using scissors. Several readiness papers will also reinforce our theme.

CONCEPT: The colors *brown* and *purple* are added to the shelves this week. At the water table, the children will use sponges and cups to transfer water from one object to another. If we have snow available, we will bring some in and play with it at the water table. Please make sure your child has a pair of gloves that they can wear for this activity. Numbers 1 through 20 and positional words are reviewed this week as well.

MOTOR: The children will be using the stair steps and balance beam in an obstacle course. Our daily exercising will have a few new moves added this week.
