Planes, trains and automobiles will be arriving, along with buses and dump trucks. We will even be pretending to be windshield wipers! We will also be introducing two new actions words; come and go.

Art: This week we are talking about transportation. There will be fun coloring, painting and mosaicing things that go. In addition to the discussion about planes, trains and automobiles, we will also learn the action words come and go. What an exciting and action packed week!
