Language Arts: The boys and girls will begin a new 2 week unit on transportation. We will learn that transportation is the way we move people and things from one place to another. We'll discover the many ways in which we can travel – by land, water or air. We will also discuss different types of working machines. The children will learn how these special vehicles are used for construction, emergencies and other purposes. We'll enjoy the book "How Will We Get to the Beach" by Brigitte Luciani and Mrs. Debbie will close the unit by having the students make a class book about transportation for our library. On Friday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> we will enjoy some simply "Seussarific" activities to celebrate the birthday of this famous author!

<u>Concept:</u> These next 2 weeks we will focus on different forms of transportation. To reinforce the theme the children will have fun playing our special transportation jobs. We'll also play a game that will help us learn positional words like in, over, and between. Different objects will be placed in water and we will guess if they will sink or float. Items in the tactile bag will help us use descriptive words like rough, smooth, and scratchy.

<u>Craft & Writing</u>: The next two weeks we will incorporate our theme of transportation into several art projects. Some papers will include identifying similarities and differences between objects and review of other concepts introduced this year. March 2nd we will celebrate Dr. Seuss's birthday by making the Cat in the Hat.
