Language Arts -

For the next two weeks our discussions will be on mammals. Please have your child bring in pictures of mammals for our collage. On Friday, March 16th remember to wear green for St. Patrick's Day. We'll have a wee little story of a cleaver tiny leprechaun and we'll be looking for his pot of gold! We will be working on new phonetic games, beginning and ending sounds, making sentences with mixing up words and word families. Story #10 will be introduced "I can"

Motor -

We will have fun with animal actions as we act out our animal friends to music. Work on ball handling

Art and Writing -

Our readiness papers will include our theme of mammals. We will also do a paper on where mammals live. We will have papers on sequencing, patterning and connecting the dots. Concept -

We will learn about are tigers, monkeys, elephants and many more mammals. We will be using our bears for measuring distance and height in math.
