Theme: Birds

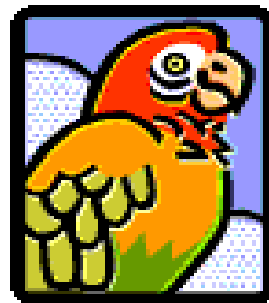
Language Arts:
