Introduce:Ee

Concept: For the next two weeks we will be learning about farms. We will continue with size seriation using different animals you find on a farm. We will learn some position words such as in, out, up, down, first, and last. The children will enjoy seeing these words in action as they place animals in a barn, over a barn, etc. Sorting animals by color and type will be a challenge - but we can do it!

Language Arts: For the next 2 weeks in Ms. Kristy's class the children will be talking about Farms. We will look at animals that are found on a farm and jobs the farmers have to do.
