<u>Language Arts</u>: In celebration of Earth Day this week the boys and girls will learn about the various ways we can care for and protect our environment. Mrs. Debbie will teach the children about the three "R's" of ecology – <u>reduce</u>, <u>reuse</u>, and <u>recycle!</u> We will also discuss trees. We will learn why trees are so important to our planet and how to identify the different parts of a tree. The book "The Great Kapok Tree" by Lynne Cherry will be featured for story time.
