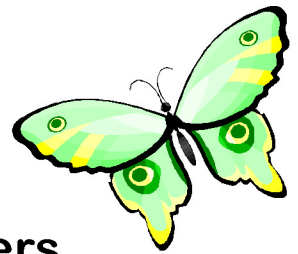

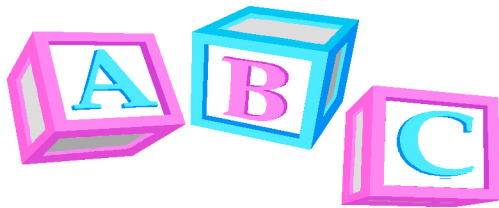
We are closed on Monday, May 28th for Memorial Day.

Craft and Writing

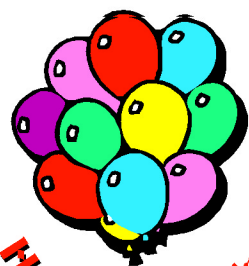
