Language Arts: This week the boys and girls will practice printing the days of the week and months of the year. By this point in the school year, the students should be able to recognize both concepts in print. We will continue to practice proper letter formation and sentence structure during daily papers and writing activities. We will spend time reviewing letter sounds and blends. Graduation practice and program practice will also take place.

Readiness assessments: Our assessments are taking place on May 7th - 11th! Please make sure your child has a good night sleep, as well as a good breakfast each day. If at all possible, please try to avoid being absent or tardy.



Math: The class will get to complete a spring flower graphing activity along with ordinal numbers and size activities. We will continue to review subtraction, telling time, and rote counting.

Science: We will explore many different types of plants and the boys and girls will learn that plants can be flowers, shrubs, or trees and they all need water, air and sunlight to grow. The boys and girls will learn that trees are the biggest plants in the world and we will be studying deciduous trees and evergreen trees. We will look at the differences between the trees and spend time looking at the rings inside of tree trunks to determine how old a tree is.
