Language Arts: This week in Ms. Kristy's class we will be discussing many different kinds of bugs. The children will be learning some new finger plays like "A Bug on Me" and "I'm a Little Ladybug." We will also look at some cool flannel board stories, "Color Butterflies" and "Wiggle Worms." Also, we will read some interesting stories about bugs including one of our favorites *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* by Eric Carle.

Concept: By the light of the moon a little egg lay on a leaf—one spring morning when the sun came up, pop! Out of the egg came a fuzzy caterpillar.
