Craft & Writing: This week the children will be completing papers that reinforce our shapes: circle and square. Scissors skills will be practiced with straight line cutting papers. Shaving cream and play dough will be used for building our fine motor skills. The children will also be painting dinosaurs.

Concept: If you have any dinosaurs that you would like to send to school for our science table display please be sure they are labeled with your child's name on them. We will be discussing various types of dinosaurs. The children will also be working on estimation this week. We will add circle and square to our art shelf activities.

Motor: The children will be playing a game following directions. We will also be going outside weather permitting.
