First of all, we would like to extend a warm welcome to all of our new students. Welcome to the Bobbie Noonan's Family, we hope you're happy here! For all those who were enrolled in our Summer Camp it's been fun playing with you, but we're ready for learning! This newsletter is our way of keeping you filled in about our lesson plan for the upcoming week as well as any special events happening at school. It is important that you read it every week so that you can work at home with your children on the same themes.

Our focus for the 1st couple of weeks of school is "getting acquainted." We'll be settling down in our new classroom and meeting all of our new friends. We will begin to establish a daily routine and try to learn the school rules.

Our class time activities will take place between 9:15 and 11:45. During this time we will do both group and individual activities with the children, such as stories, puzzles and listening activities.

Miss Kristy will be teaching Language Arts and Concept. I have been working at Bobbie Noonan's for 10 years. I absolutely love working with children and watching them grow and learn each day. In Language Arts, the children will learn flannel board stories, fingerplays, and songs. They will also learn the letters Aa-Ee along with the phonetic sound. In Concept, the children will learn the numbers 1-6. We will also discuss the weather and calendar daily.

Ms. Tammy will be teaching Craft and Writing and Motor. I have been working at Bobbie Noonan's for over 3 years. I look forward to a fun year with your child! In Craft and Writing, the children will learn their colors, how to paint, mosaic, and how to hold a crayon correctly. In Motor we will be working on body awareness, balance, and a sense of directionality.
