Introduce: Aa and Bb

Concept- We will be reviewing the rules that we learned last week. Also, Aa and Bb will be added to the shelf. We will also learn about estimating throughout the week, For the group activities, the group will compare and contrast, use the tactile bag and practice size sorting. On the shelves, several jobs will be introduced. One job is called the alphabet buckets. There is a container for each letter of the alphabet filled with objects whose initial sound is the same as that letter.
