Week 5: September 17-21, 2018

Theme: A Trip to the Zoo

Language Arts:

We'll be going on an imaginary trip to the zoo through various flannel board stories including: *Going to the Zoo* and *Zoo Visit*. We'll later discuss the difference between animals that are pets, and zoo animals. We will enjoy finger plays, including: *I'm a Lion* and *I'm a Monkey*. The children will take a trip to the zoo through various flannel board stories. In addition to our zoo theme, we will continue singing some of our favorite songs, *Itsy, Bitsy Spider*, *Grizzly Bears*, and *Twinkle, Twinkle*. We'll use our rhythm sticks

to make music.

Concept:

We will continue to review our calendar and weather on a daily basis. We will be celebrating our first day of fall on Sunday. We'll also be discussing the difference between the terms big and little, with several examples in the classroom. The letter Aa, will be added to all self jobs. We will also do a block activity this week. How tall can we build the tower? Lastly, we'll be discussing the zoo, and find several examples of zoo animals on our shelves!

Motor:

We will continue playing outdoors, to enjoy the changing season! Indoors, we'll play the body parts and follow the directions games. The children will also practice their hand-eye coordination at the ball and wand.

Craft and Writing:

We'll be doing several papers to help us learn our new letter Aa. We'll also work on zoo pattern papers, and a zoo collage. Lastly, we'll be tearing paper, tracing, and finger painting!
