Language Arts:

We will introduce our new reading story Missy Manners. Missy Manners always promotes using good manners. Over these next two weeks, we'll also be discussing one of the children's favorites, dinosaurs. Our expressive vocabulary words all relate to dinosaurs, along with the words fossil, extinct, omnivorous, carnivorous, and herbivorous. The children will also enjoy this dinosaur finger play:

When I walk I stomp (stamp feet three times)

It sounds like thunder (cover ears)

I'm so big and round (spread

arms wide)

That children wonder (tap side of head)

Concept:

The sand table will be set up as our dinosaur dig. Which type of dinosaur will you find? We will continue to work on our estimation activities.
