Language Arts: The children will spend the week reviewing concepts such as word families, and long and short vowels. We will discuss popcorn words, words that keep popping up in every day print, such as the words **of** and **the**. We will be reading stories that include some of our popcorn words. As a group, we will search a story for popcorn words. We will “butter” those words with our yellow markers. What a fun way to find words we know!

Math: We will begin to work on measurement this week. The children will be using rulers to work on several fun activities. Other math lessons will include a review of numbers 1-20 and we will continue to practice correct printing techniques as well as numeral concept of our numbers. The boys and girls will also spend time working on place value and geometric solid shapes. Ordinal numbers will be reviewed by identifying objects in the given position (ex. color the fifth flower in the row.)

Science: We will discuss police officers and learn the job duties and requirements of police officers. We will also learn about the police station and the types of police officers we have in our cities. The season of fall will be a topic of interest this week as we will discuss the science behind why leaves are changing colors and falling from the trees. The children will be making leaf rubbings using leaves from our nature walk!

Social Studies: We will discuss what number to call in case of an emergency and other safety tips. The states California and Colorado will be introduced.
