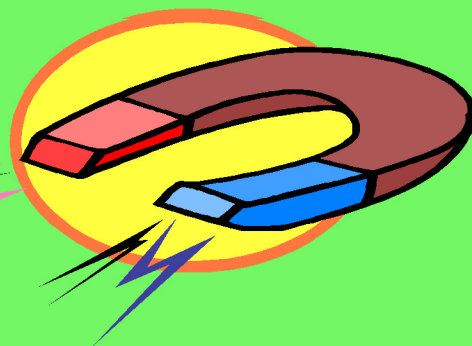
PROVERB
