Theme: Nursery Rhymes

Language Arts:

The children will learn several nursery rhymes including: Jack and Jill, Mary Had a Little Lamb, Baa Baa Black Sheep, and Humpty Dumpty. Books, flannel boars and stories. and finger plays will help us explore these nursery rhymes. We'll also have fun with the finger plays Pat-a-Cake and Five Little Piggies. We will also review all of our letters, numbers, colors, and shapes that have been introduced so far this year.

Concept:

We will continue to review our colors and shapes, by

sorting them appropriately. The alphabet bucket Aa and number buckets 1 and 2, will help reinforce these previous introductions. For science. The children will be discussing, and looking for fall changes. To enhance our theme, the children will jump over a pretend candlestick, as we sing Jack be nimble, Jack be quick!
