Language Arts: This week we will continue our alphabet review with the letters Ww and Xx. Printing practice will continue and our phonics workbook pages will help us become familiar with words that start with our new letters for the week.

<u>Math</u>: The children are doing a great job with addition. This week we will complete a fun seed solution addition activity. In this activity the class will count seeds from apples and pumpkins and add the number of seeds together to get a solution. Have your heard your child count by 5's or 10's? Driving in the car is a great time to practice all sorts of counting activities.

Science: We will continue learning about the Earth and look at how much of the Earth is covered by land and water. We will spend time talking about day and night by learning the fun poem. We will have fun with a sink and float exploration activity where the students will place fall objects in water to see if they sink or float. We will also be observing a chemical reaction and the anatomy of an egg during our "naked egg" experiment.
