Theme: Fall

Introduce: Bb, brown & purple

Weeks of 11/5 & 11/12

Concept: We think Fall is Fabulous! We're going to spend the next two weeks talking about what happens during the Autumn months. This week in concept we will also be exploring our Science bin and searching for Fall items. The letter Bb and the colors brown and purple will be introduced. We will continue with one to one correspondence using cups and saucers, and having the children place one block in a few dump trucks.

Motor: We're keeping fit for Fall. We'll have plenty of time staying active by walking on the balance beam and going up and down the stair steps. We'll play block bowling to introduce Bb, brown, and purple. We will have fun outside, so please make sure your child is dressed appropriately.

Language Arts: Get ready for Language Arts! We will be learning many new flannel board stories, finger plays and songs about Fall. We'll look at Fall pictures like children playing in the leaves and bundling up to play outside. Bb, brown, and purple will be introduced. We will hear about Jack Frost who leaves the grass all frosty for the morning.
