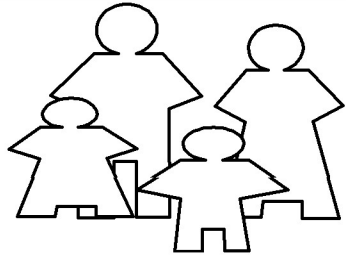

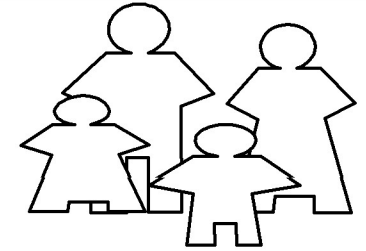


Introductions: 9 & 10
