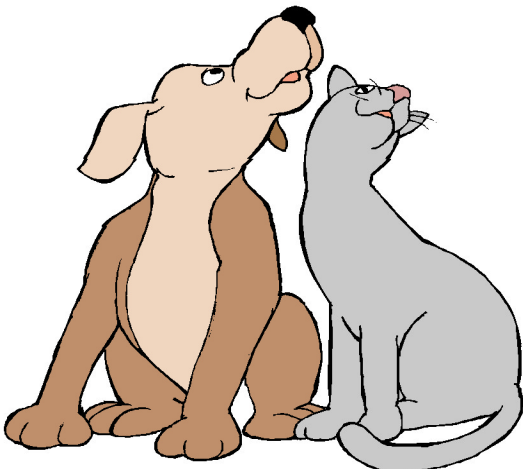


Language Arts

Now that we have completed the entire alphabet, we will be backtracking to the letters Aa and Bb, this time focusing on sharpening up our printing skills.

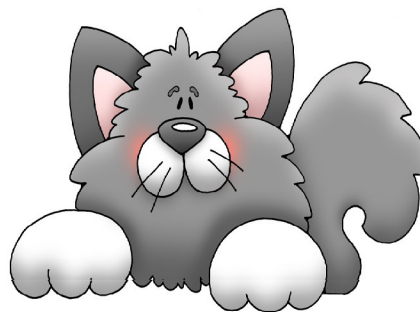
At this time we will begin using printing paper on a regular basis. In addition to this, the children will begin to print both their first and last names on their papers.

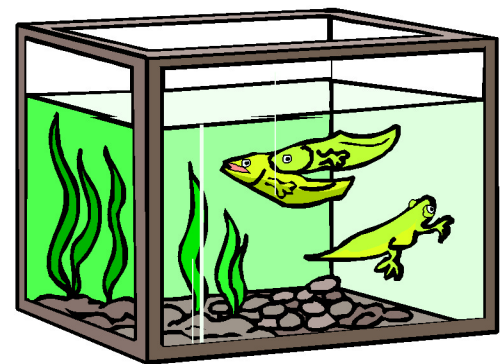
