SONG OF THE WEEK: "Stand Up/Sit Down"

Stand up – wiggle toes

Sit down – pat your knees

Tap your chin, cheeks,

Stand up – stretch up high.

LANGUAGE ARTS: To follow along with our themes, we will be learning new songs and finger plays. We will be looking at pictures of *winter* and talking about them. The children will enjoy listening to a flannel board about snowmen and icicles. A listening and following directions game will also help get us up and moving this first week back after our holidays. The words to this activity are included in this newsletter for your enjoyment.

CRAFT & WRITING: The children will be making a variety of *winter* art projects; including a paper snow globe, snowflake, sponge painting, and a cotton-ball snowman. We will also work on papers reviewing our new letter Cc.

CONCEPT: During class we will work on a fine motor activity using our water table and ice cubes. If there is snow outside, we might even put some snow in the water table! Lego's will be used this week as we work on color recognition. A group activity will also be done using blocks. The children will match different shaped and sized blocks to the correct outline. We will also be adding letter Cc jobs to our shelves.

MOTOR: We will be working on hand/eye coordination with the ball and wand activity. A new game, "Snow Sweeping" will also help with hand/eye coordination. The tumbling mat will be reintroduced and we will work on log rolls and jumping.
