





**Language Arts**: Our picture file will link careers to places and people in the community. With the use of rhythm sticks, the children will have fun listening and echoing different songs. We will review our manners by reading "Manners at School" and "Please say, Please".

**Concept:** We will add sponges to the water table and fill different sized containers. A seriation activity will keep us busy as we determine "how full" something is by using rainbow water bottles. We will continue to explore positional words as a class.

<u>Craft & Writing:</u> With the use of tissue paper and paint, our new colors will be introduced. Our cutting skills will be put to the test as we cut a double curved line. We will make a "chef hat" to enhance our theme.

**Motor:** With the help of the balance board, our balancing skills and our eye hand coordination will be tested as we practice tossing a ball. Students will also act out words that coincide with community helpers, such as "stop, drop, and roll" for firefighters.
