



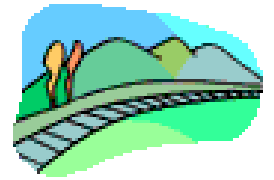

LANGUAGE ARTS: Letters Oo and Pp will be introduced this week, along with their phonetic sounds. Reading stories 1-3 are reviewed, and we will introduce story #4. Our discussions about *transportation* continue this week. If your child has pictures or books about our theme, please send them to be shared with the class.

CRAFT AND WRITING: Papers reinforcing our new letters; Oo and Pp, will be done. We will also continue working on our scissor skills with double angle cutting. Fine motor skills are further developed through the practice of tracing our names, letters, and shapes.

CONCEPT: The letters Oo and Pp are added to the shelf activities this week. The children will also continue working on *transportation* jobs. For Math, the children will continue working with pattern cards and activities reinforcing the numbers 11-20.

MOTOR: This week the children will be playing a bean bag game and exercising with Mickey Mouse. To wrap up our week, the children will have fun doing an obstacle course in our classroom. We will go outside; weather permitting. Please be sure your child has their outside clothing here each day.
