We will begin our Solar System unit by discussing our home planet, Earth. The students will learn about day and night and the rotation of the Earth.



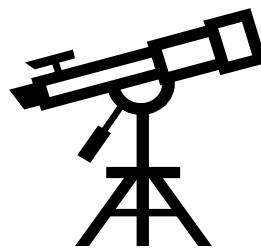
