Concept:

The children had such a great time learning about the Solar System that we've decided to extend the topic for another week. We will touch on star constellations and how to identify them.

Our place value study has gone so well, we are ready to incorporate hundreds. This will also serve as a help to the children as they begin counting money in a few weeks. (ten pennies makes one dime, ten dimes or one hundred pennies makes one dollar)

Our time study will now include 15 minute increments. We will use the terms "quarter after" and "quarter to."



**** We will begin a new project involving home and school, it is the estimation jar. The students will take turns sending home the weekly jar to fill. You may fill it with the item of your choice....be creative! It should be returned the following day so the class can make their estimations as to how many objects are in the jar. This will be done once a week.
