

Theme: Solar System


Language Arts

The children seem to be off to a great start with subtraction. Please keep in mind that at this point is is not uncommon to confuse the plus and minus signs.


We began playing math games using addition and subtraction flash cards such as "Around the World". Ask your child if they made it completely around the whole classroom!
