Summer and Fall Registration

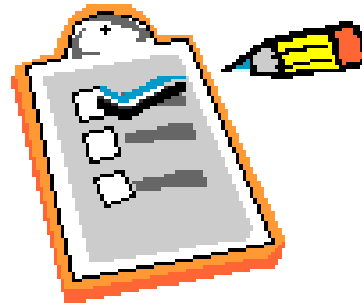
Summer 2019 and Fall 2019-2020 registration is open now with an early bird discount!!
