What's going on in Mrs. Jackie's class? Week #20-21 winter

We hope everyone had an enjoyable winter break! 2019 is upon us and we have so much more to learn in the upcoming months. We are halfway through our school year! The next two weeks we will focus on winter.

If there are any parents in the health or fitness field that would like to come in and speak about their profession or passion we would gladly welcome you over the next two weeks. Just let us know what day and time would be good for you and we will schedule you accordingly. The students especially love when we have visitors in our class.

Language Arts – The letters Ss, Tt, Uu, and Vv will be introduced, along with their phonetic sounds. We will begin learning how to build words, sound out words, build sentences, and start looking at word families. Reading story #6 will be introduced. Our discussions will be centered on winter, nutrition and exercise.

Motor- Throwing and catching snowballs will be some of the motor activities we will work on. Along with yoga moves and balance beam taking place each day.

Concept – The numbers 11, 12, 13 and 14 will be introduced. We will talk about winter and what changes we see and feel. We will be working on our number words (i.e. one, two, etc.) The Golden Beads will be introduced. Golden Beads will provide them with the concept of place value starting with ones and tens. We will continue exploring them over the next several weeks.

Craft and Writing- In Science we will discuss winter and how animals behave during this time of year. We will add puzzles about our theme on our job shelves. We will also work on a class food pyramid. Please have your child bring in a few pictures of food to add to our pyramid. We will also discuss germs and different ways we can prevent from spreading them. We will be doing printing papers of the numbers 11, 12, 13, 14. We will also be completing readiness papers about rhyming, patterning, and a snowman craft is sure to be in store for our winter theme.

We will begin evaluating the students for the second time and begin preparation for Parent/Teacher conferences scheduled for February. More information regarding conferences will be sent home.
