Theme: Transportation

Language Arts: We will enjoy several books, and learn about transportation through surprise picture cards and finger plays. Our finger plays will include: My Little Sailboat, I'm a Choo-Choo Train, and Traffic Lights. We will also look at the flannel board stories Five Little Dump Trucks and Little Red Train. In addition to learning various forms of transportation, we will learn various traffic signs, what the colors red, yellow, and green mean on a traffic signal.

Concept: We will continue doing our active review to help reinforce the letters, numbers, colors, and shapes previously introduced. We will also be sorting forms of transportation by where they travel: air, water, or land. Lastly, we'll enjoy the game Dump Truck Count, and explore the water table that will be filled with boats!
