## Craft and Writing

The children are writing on printing paper every day. This week, the children will start correcting the wacky sentence that is written on the board.

This skill will make them better readers and writers. St. Patrick's Day and Spring projects will decorate our classroom.

## Math & Science

The children will learn about the penny and nickel. The penny is copper brown, worth 1 cent, and Abraham Lincoln's picture is on the penny. The nickel is silver, worth 5 cents, and a picture of Thomas Jefferson is on the nickel.

In Science, we will discuss the many characteristics of farm animals and their job on the farm.

## Language

The children absolutely love reading!!! We will continue to review diagraphs and blend sounds.
