We will also play a game to help us learn the meaning of on, in, under, next to, and between. Also, the concept of "how full" things are will be introduced. Three containers with different levels will be shown and we will discuss which one is the most full.

<u>Craft & Writing</u>: This week we will be working on our new numbers 15 and 16. Mrs. Tiffany will also be reviewing all concepts introduced throughout the year. Our thinking skills will also be put to the test while we work on differentiating between same and different. We will also be working on rhyming words while reinforcing our fine motor skills.
