Theme: Shapes

Week of 3/4

Introduce: oval & rhombus



Concept: This week in concept we will be playing a shape seriation game sorting by shape and size. Oval and rhombus will be added to our daily review. The children will have fun in the block area and working with jobs off the concept shelf.

Language Arts: In Language Arts the children will have fun with the flannel board story "Sally the Square" and the puppet play "I'm a Giant Triangle." We will learn a finger play about a circle and continue with our daily review.

Art: This week in art we will be working with pattern papers of different shapes. The children will have fun coloring, mosaicing and painting. We will sponge paint an oval and a rhombus, and have fun with play dough!

Motor: In motor this week we'll practice our throwing skills by throwing a bean bag onto a mat with all that shapes we have learned. When the bean bag lands on a shape we will try to identify it. We'll also practice our aim in block bowling by knocking down an oval and rhombus. We will brush up on our favorite sports during ball play by kicking and shooting into a net

and hoop.
