



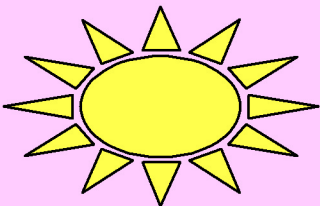
Pre-K NEWS
